This is the children's area. I can find children's books here.

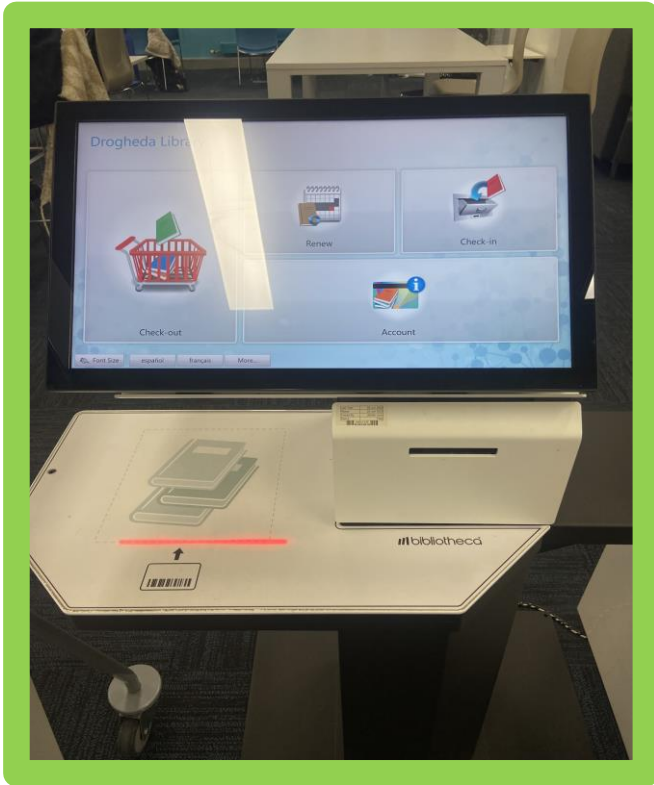
I can sit in this area and read.

I have to try to be quiet and calm in the library but it is fine to ask questions and ask for help if I need to.



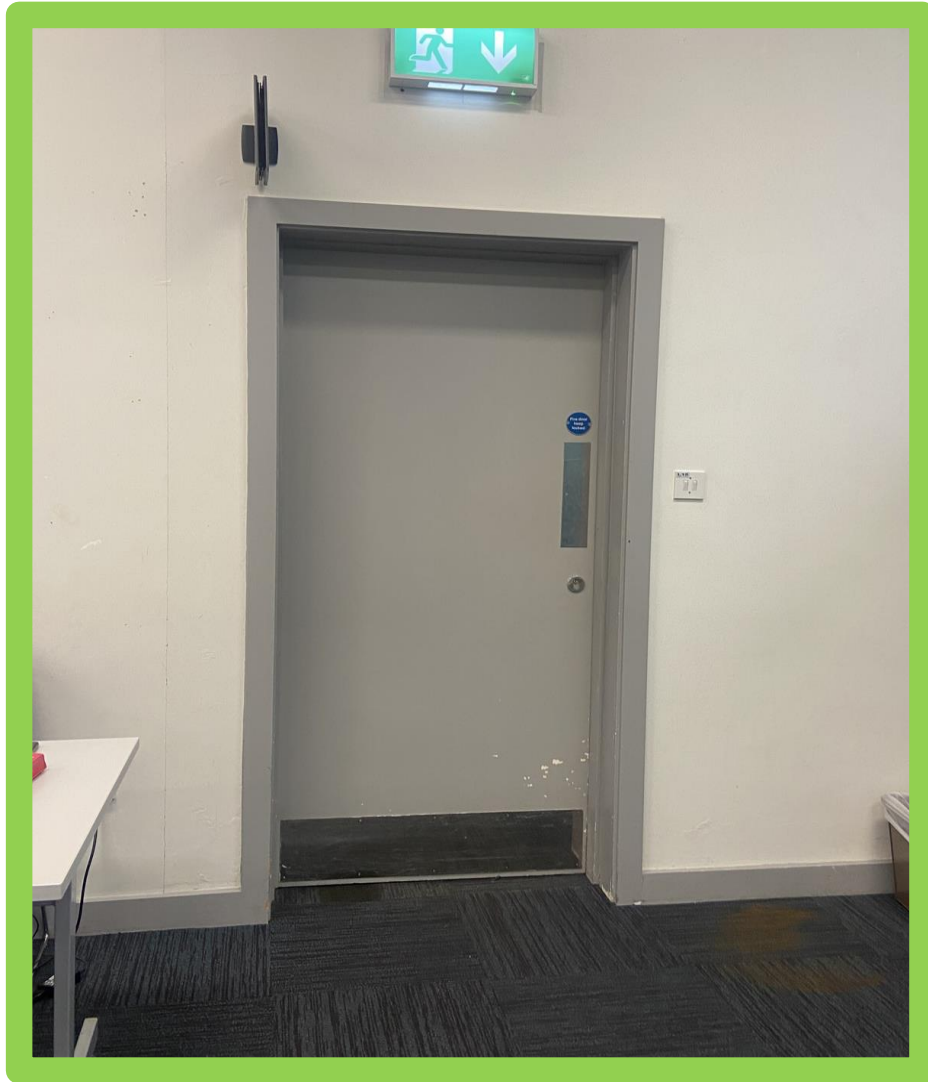
This is the help desk. If I have any questions I can ask a member of staff here.
