Its fine if I want to play a game on my own but it can be fun to play with others as well

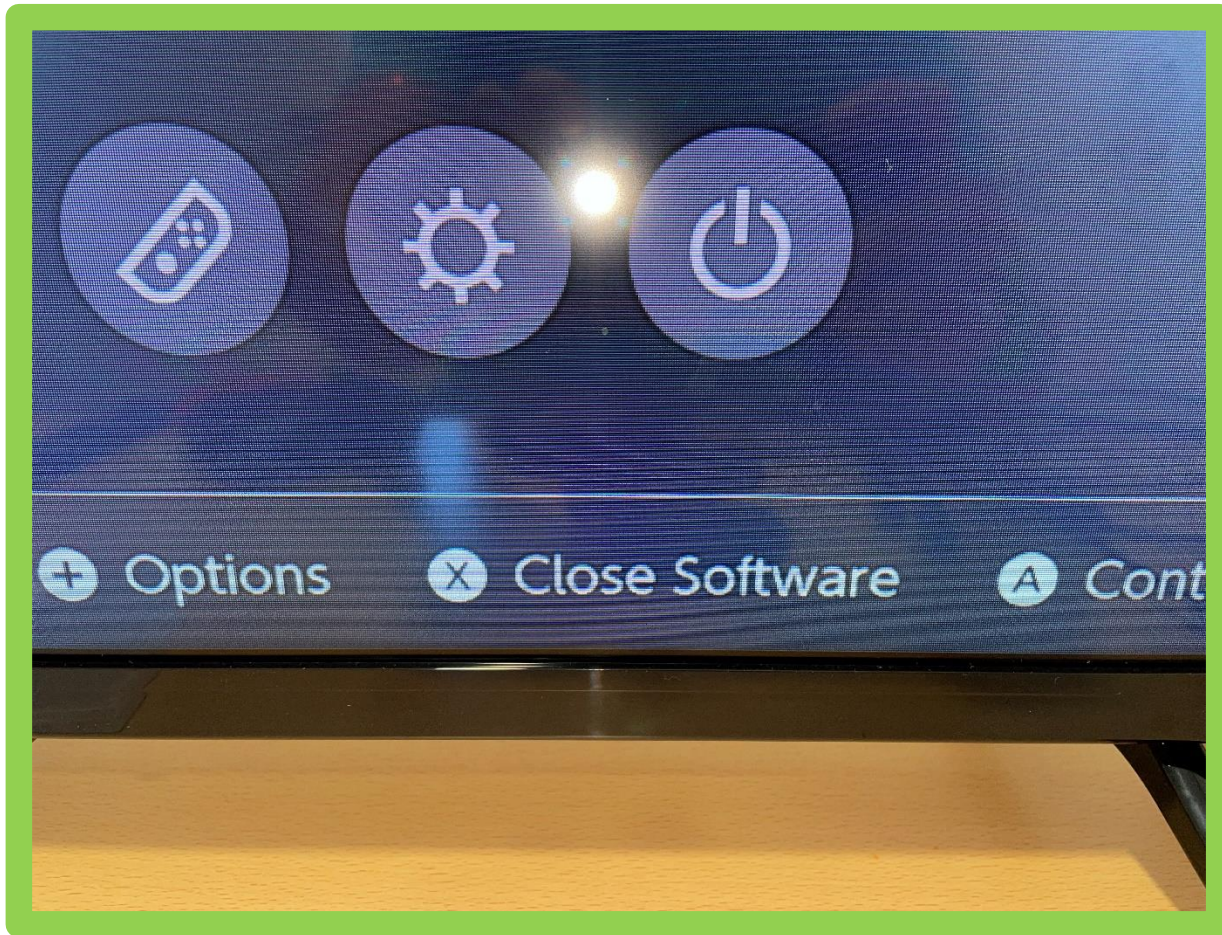


There are some very important rules to follow in the games room.

We have to play nicely and be very careful with the controllers because they can break.

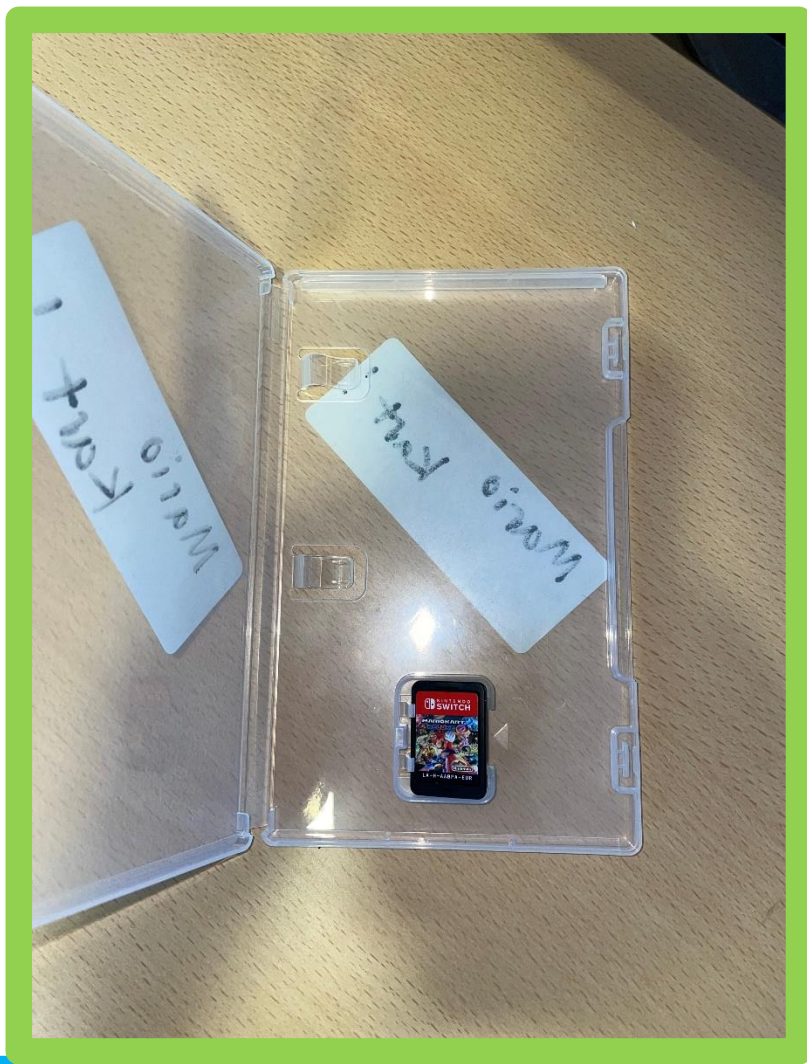
And we must take turns and make sure everyone gets a chance to play.
